## **Leviticus 23:2**

**2 “Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, These are the appointed feasts of the Lord that you shall proclaim as holy convocations; they are my appointed feasts.**

**17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was in the act of offering up his only son, 18 of whom it was said, "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named." 19 He considered that God was able even to raise him from the dead, from which, figuratively speaking, he did receive him back.**

## Atonement (Yom Kippur)

### Leviticus 16:6

6 “Aaron shall offer the bull as a sin offering for himself and shall make atonement for himself and for his house.



### Leviticus 16:9-10

9 And Aaron shall present the goat on which the lot fell for the Lord and use it as a sin offering, 10 but the goat on which the lot fell for Azazel shall be presented alive before the Lord to make atonement over it, that it may be sent away into the wilderness to Azazel.



## Atonement (Yom Kippur)

**Hebrews 7:22-27**

**22 This makes Jesus the guarantor of a better covenant. 23 The former priests were many in number, because they were prevented by death from continuing in office, 24 but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever... 26 For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. 27 He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, since he did this once for all when he offered up himself.**



## **Atonement (Yom Kippur)**

### **Leviticus 16:29-31**

**"This shall be a statute forever for you: In the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, whether a native of your own country or a stranger who dwells among you. For on that day the priest shall make atonement for you, to cleanse you, that you may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. It is a sabbath of solemn rest for you, and you shall afflict your souls. It is a statute forever.**



## **Atonement (Yom Kippur)**

**Luke 18:13-14**

**And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!' I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."**



## **Atonement (Yom Kippur)**

**28 And you shall not do any work on that very day, for it is a Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the Lord your God. 29 For whoever is not afflicted on that very day shall be cut off from his people. 30 And whoever does any work on that very day, that person I will destroy from among his people.**

**Ephesians 2:8-9**

**8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.**



## **Atonement (Yom Kippur)**

### **Revelation 20:11-15**

**11 Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it... 12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged... according to what they had done. 13... Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. 14 Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire...15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.**





## Tabernacles (Sukkot)



### Deuteronomy 16:16

**16 “Three times a year all your males shall appear before the Lord your God at the place that he will choose: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Booths. They shall not appear before the Lord empty-handed.**





## Tabernacles (Sukkot)



**John 7:2**

**2 Now the Jews' Feast of Booths was at hand.**

**John 7:10**

**10 But after his brothers had gone up to the feast, then he also went up, not publicly but in private.**



## **Tabernacles (Sukkot)**



**Isaiah 12:3-4**

**3 With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.**

**John 7:37-38**

**37 On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. 38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'"**



## **Tabernacles (Sukkot)**

**Revelation 21:1-4, 6**

**2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God..."**

**6 And he said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment."**



## **Tabernacles (Sukkot)**

### **John 8:12**

**12 Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."**

### **Revelation 22:5**

**5 And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever.**



## **Tabernacles (Sukkot)**

### **Zechariah 14:16-17**

**16 Then everyone who survives of all the nations that have come against Jerusalem shall go up year after year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Booths. 17 And if any of the families of the earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, there will be no rain on them.**



## **Tabernacles (Sukkot)**

**Psalms 40:7**

**Then I said, "Behold, I come;  
In the scroll of the book it is written of me.**

**Hebrews 10:5-7**

**Therefore, when He came into the world, He said:  
"Sacrifice and offering You did not desire,  
But a body You have prepared for Me.  
In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin  
You had no pleasure.**

**Then I said, 'Behold, I have come—  
In the volume of the book it is written of Me—  
To do Your will, O God.'"**
